The most commonly cultivated red wine variety grown in Germany, Dornfelder produces wines of dark color with rich, velvety texture. Much of this variety is used for blending and color

stabilization. However, varietals are common.

Viticultural Notes

Grape: Dornfelder

Harvest Date: Sept. 15, 2017

Dornfelder is a very vigorous variety that can crop very large amounts of grapes. Care must be taken to thin cropload to ensure good ripening in cooler climates. The vines have a good resistance to botrytis bunch rot and is very thick skinned,
